A Note From the Director

This month we will focus on the topic of All About Me as we get to know one another and establish our new school routine. We are excited to share that our school has a new daily routine designed to give children a balanced mix of Montessori learning, group activities, and creative exploration. This structure allows us to keep learning fun and meaningful while also helping each child grow in confidence and independence.

OUR DAILY ROUTINE includes:

- . Circle Time Building community and setting the tone for the day.
- Montessori Presentations Daily demonstrations (except Wednesdays) of core Montessori lessons such as rolling a rug, pouring water, or working with math and language materials. After watching, children will have the chance to practice the activity themselves. Each week, presentations will include a practical life skill along with a math, language, or sensorial lesson.

A Note From the Director ... Continued

- Smart Circle Dedicated group instruction that rotates between Math and Language. Math days will include games, counting with manipulatives, dry-erase number writing, and number stories. Language days will focus on alphabet sounds, vowels, rhyming words, and letter writing practice. On Wednesdays, Smart Circle will be Show & Tell, where children can share something from home (small enough to fit in their cubby) and practice their public speaking.
- Work Cycles & 1:1 Teacher Time Opportunities for independent exploration and individual guidance.
- Crafts, Directed Art, and Worksheets Encouraging creativity and fine motor development in a group setting of instruction.
- Practical Life & Dramatic Play Building independence, social skills,
 and real-world understanding
- Story Time & Movement Activities Supporting literacy, imagination, and healthy bodies.

To keep our classroom focused and organized, we've created three small learning groups. Children will rotate through activities in these groups and also come together during shared times of the day.

We are thrilled to begin this enriching schedule and look forward to welcoming back our returning students as well as new friends joining us this month. It's going to be a wonderful year of growth, discovery, and joy!
